Alpha Houses Remain Full

Keeping our Alpha House transitional housing units at full capacity has always been challenging because when we commit to each new arrival their "spot" is secure but they do not always fill it. The reasons vary. It may or may not be within the control of the new resident but every vacancy is filled only as we can be sure we can accept them.

This often results in being at less than full capacity. Over the past couple years or so, this balancing act has gone fairly smoothly and we've remained at near full capacity most of the time. Right now is among those times.

Gino successfully moved out in August prior to his marriage, and we congratulate him on a double success, and we have two new residents in August, Brian and Tony, plus the three from July, RJ, Mario, and Tim. On occasion, we get new residents who have been in prison for a long time. The new August arrival is just such a case. As we celebrate 40 years as a ministry, Brian has been incarcerated just as long.

We welcome Brian and also ask prayers on his behalf. That's a long time to spend outside of society, but having a safe place to make this transition, having prayer, mentoring and encouragement, provides the mix that has helped many others flourish even after such long periods of time in prison.
